Food waste!



The above photo is the school meals ordered by families one day last week, even though the children were not present in school. This is unnecessary food waste. The pupils present in school also do not want it. The above photo is just under 100 Euros worth of food. Due to re-heating regulations, the food in this photo is sadly dumped. This is now a daily occurrence due to food not being cancelled when it is not needed. This roughly equates to about 450-500 Euros worth of food being dumped per week, or in other words about 2,000 Euros per month. To put that in perspective, that is equivalent to:

- **50% of our school's oil heating bill to keep pupils warm for a whole year!**
- **or the price of a new interactive whiteboard for pupils in a classroom.**
- **or arts and crafts supplies for all pupils for one year**
- **or 2 educational psychological assessments for 2 pupils**
- **or 5 new tablets for pupils**
- **or wages for 2 SNAs**

None of the above, by the way which we have the funds to do! We can only dream! Due to rising running costs and Government funding not matching inflation, we run at an annual deficit of just over 10,000 Euro per year. We depend on bun sales and fundraising to make ends meet.

I think you get the idea. Whilst the Hot School Meals scheme can have many positives, it can and does lead to a shocking amount of wasted resources, that could and may be should be better spent.

Please in the interests of reducing waste, protecting the environment, and in common sense terms of what previous generations would have said, that's it's "a sin to throw out food",
